

## The cat colonies of Aegina

Volunteers and also our shelter worker Lori volunteer on Aegina to take care of the many supervised cat colonies on Aegina, which consist of more than 100 cats. Not only are the cats fed and watered daily, but they are also checked for injuries. The new arrivals are examined, their sex is determined and, if necessary, neutering is initiated. The animals that have already been castrated can be recognised by their severed ear tips (this is of course done by the vet during anaesthesia).

We would like to thank all donors who entrust us with funds through our German support association Aegean Dogs e. V., which we can then make available to animal welfare on Aegina. In this case it was an order of dry food for the street cats.
