

Appeal for donations - hard times - big challenges

Each of us feels it in our own wallet. Everything is getting more expensive, and the trend is rising. There is no end in sight. And yet the problems and new construction sites in animal welfare are not abating. We do our best and try with all our strength to keep the shelter going. It is a daily battle against the storm, but we always stay upright!

All our private foster homes for cats on Aegina are maxed out. More is not possible. And so we had no choice but to convert part of our day rooms at the shelter into a cat hospital. We can't find any more space for the cats. Should we leave them to their fate on the street? No, you know we can't - no one could.

But: Even though we do everything we can, it is not a species-appropriate accommodation, because overnight we have to lock them up in flight boxes.

But now we had the idea of converting one of the last empty enclosures for the dogs - located out of the way, therefore never occupied by dogs - so that the enclosure can be used in a cat-proof way. So that they can better participate in life, be outside in the fresh air. We hope that the physical and psychological healing process will then progress more quickly.

We need to hire a locksmith to redesign the enclosure: we need a roof on the enclosure, we need a double entrance door with a corridor and the existing wire mesh fence needs to be made more cat-proof. We would also like to add a privacy fence to increase the calmness for the cats. We also have to take care of the interior decoration, but the surrounding forest with its fallen branches and tree trunks can help us.

We ask you for financial support for this project. Together we can do it! Every small contribution helps us a bit further. Please help us for the poor souls.

If the cats can be rehomed after recovery, we would do so, otherwise they will come back to their place of origin recovered, but then with a new chance and above all healthy.
