Now that we have digested yesterday fairly well, we are sending you the first updates on Aeneas, who is no longer a nobody dog but will be protected by Animal Protection from today and in the future.

He is slowly showing trust in our staff and is allowing himself to be touched and stroked. Nobody can blame him for being suspicious of everyone after that terrible day!

Except for one photo, we want to spare you the true cruelty. Aeneas was covered in blood from the shots that crushed his front legs at the upper joints when he was dropped off at the vet's surgery:



He will go to a specialised clinic in Athens on a pet transport. There they will try to stabilise his front legs. A long rehabilitation process will then begin. We hope that one day he will be able to walk again. The operation costs alone amount to 3000 euros including VAT.

Please help us so that we can cover these costs and the rehabilitation costs. Aeneas does not deserve to be abandoned. He was simply in the wrong place at the wrong time.
