

Nachruf Beau - Brisco



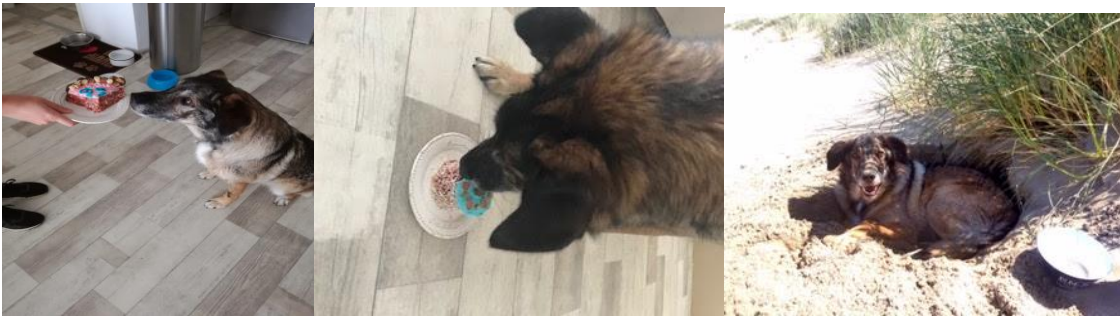
